

Dunchurch Parish Council crime report

For the period of August 1st until August 31st 2011:

Burglary Dwellings – 1

- **Rugby Road**, Dunchurch (05/08/2011)

Daytime break in via ground floor window; Jewellery and cash taken

Most burglaries to date result in jewellery being taken. Advice is to mark all expensive jewellery with Smartwater and take photos with you wearing it. Further, ensure that it is hidden away out of sight. Burglary continues to be the Warwickshire Police's top priority and we have seen a fall in the number of burglaries following many arrests. Patrols and other initiatives continue to be in place.

Burglary other – 2

Cawston Lane, Dunchurch (15/08/2011)

Overnight break in to a secure shed. Nothing of value stolen
Incident dealt with by Local Investigation

Green Man PH, Dunchurch (03/08/2011)

Night time break in. Nothing reported stolen

Rowdy/nuisance incidents – 0

Multi-agency initiative set up over the summer months to tackle ASB whilst youths were off from school. A successful operation

Dunchurch Park Hotel, Dunchurch (16/08/2011 and 17/08/2011)

2 x theft of wallet from conference room. On both occasions items left unattended

Village Green Hotel, Dunchurch (17/08/2011)

Theft of mobile phone by finding. Victim left mobile phone on a table outside the hotel and when she has returned it was no longer there

The Dun Cow, Dunchurch (08/08/2011)

Theft of mobile phone. Victim left mobile on the table whilst eating at the PH
